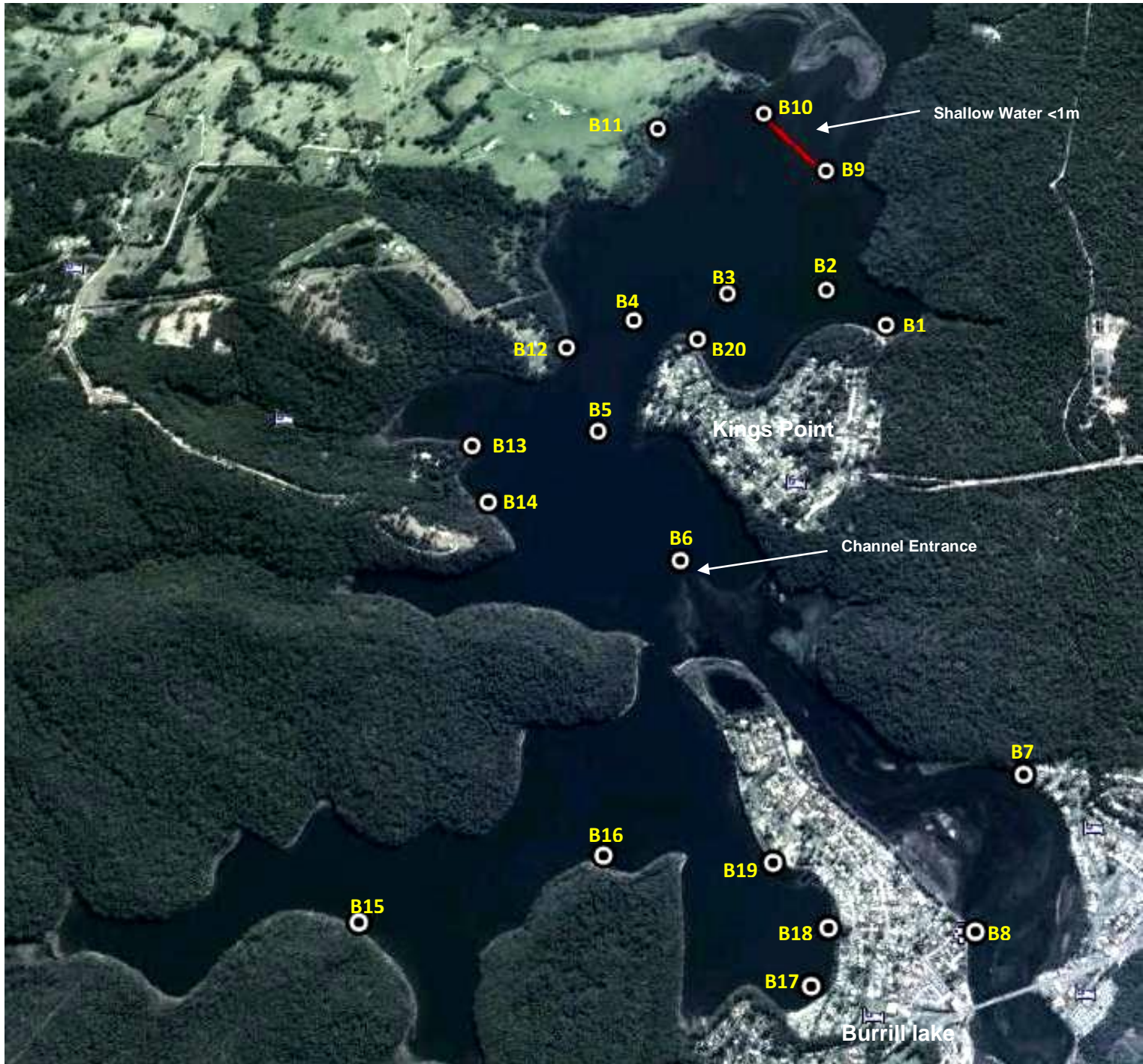


BURRILL LAKE, NSW NAVIGATION WAYPOINTS



Important Navigation Notes

- The coordinates for all locations on the shoreline (beaches, ramps) are given for a point 10-20m offshore in safe water, to allow for safe navigation to the waypoint (WP).
- Extreme caution must be exercised when navigating East of WP B6. This waypoint is at the entrance to the channel leading downstream (to the East). All navigation must strictly be within the channel markers. Depth of the channel varies between 2-3m but at time of survey was as little as 1.1m in an area just to the east of WP B6.
- In the northern end of the lake, the water depth north of a line between WP B9 and B10 is less than 1m and is non-navigable for most vessels.
