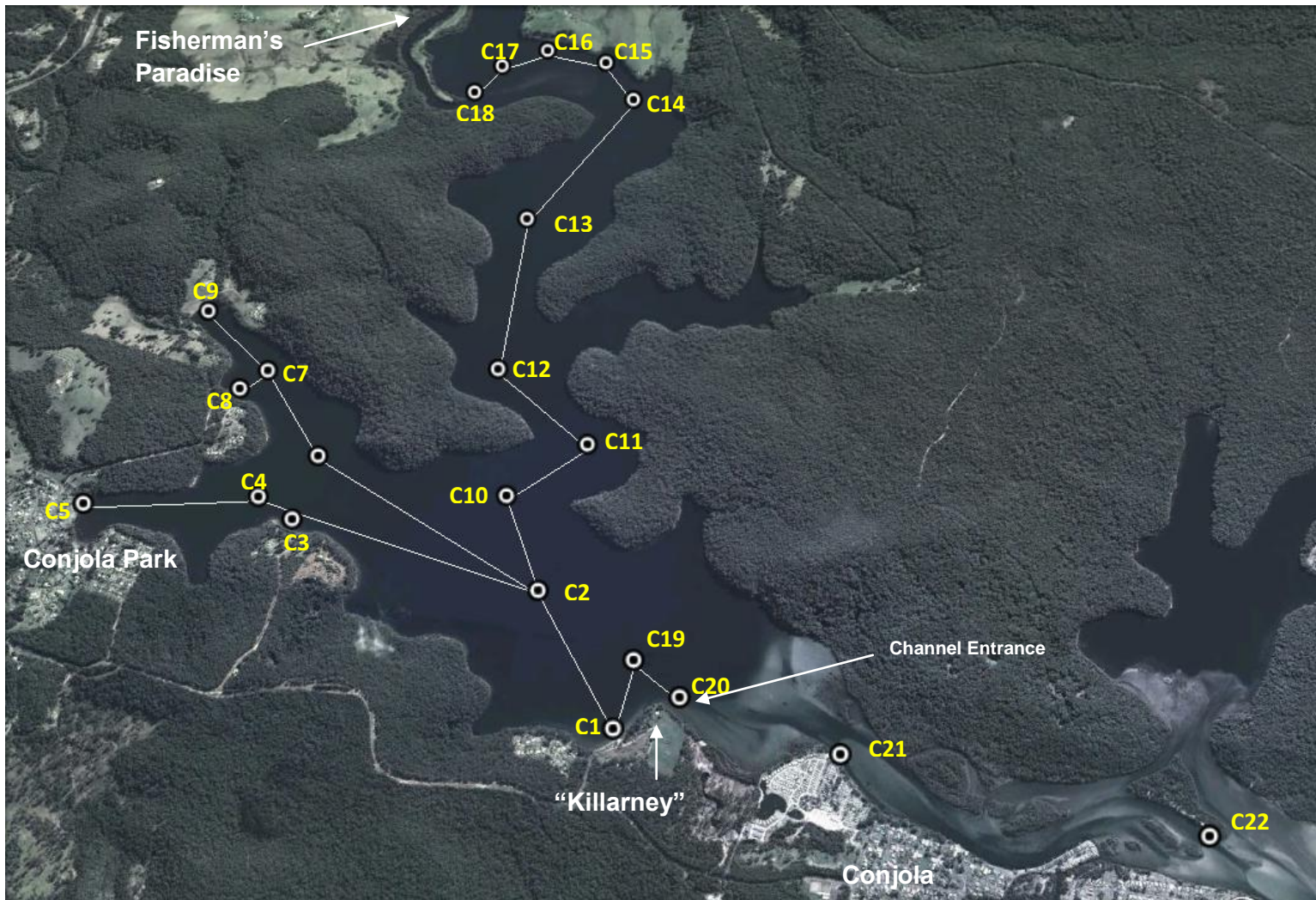


LAKE CONJOLA, NSW NAVIGATION WAYPOINTS



Important Navigation Notes

- There is no electronic navigation chart for Lake Conjola.
- Navigation via waypoints can still be used however in the absence of a chart it is strongly recommended that navigation of the Lake at night or in poor visibility be done with the assistance of radar.
- The coordinates for all locations on the shoreline (beaches, ramps) are given for a point 10-20m offshore in safe water, to allow for safe navigation to the waypoint (WP).
- Extreme caution must be exercised when navigating East of WP C20. This waypoint is at the entrance to the channel leading downstream (to the East). All navigation must strictly be within the channel markers. Depth of the channel varies between 0.5-1.5m and is non-navigable beyond C22 except for very shallow draught vessels (<0.2m).
- In the northern end of the lake, access to Fisherman's Paradise (including the boat ramp) is via Conjola Creek which is a 10-15m wide channel with thick vegetation on either side. Caution should be used in using this route in the event of fires.
